- Rasulullah ﷺ returned and told his wife, “Cover me, cover me”
- Rasulullah ﷺ told his wife, “Verily I fear for my life.”
 - Shock of the event/seeing an angel
- Khadijah (ra) – gave one of the most beautiful responses in hadith.
- Never should you fear for your soul because verily Allah will never waste you because of these certain characteristics:
 - Verily you bring together relatives and families
 - And you carry the destitute
 - And you earn for those people who don’t have livelihood
 - And you host guests
 - And you assist in truth / just causes



Dawah – “Invitation”

- After Rasulullah ﷺ received his Prophethood and visited the monk Waraqah, who also confirmed that He is the coming Prophet, Rasulullah ﷺ received another revelation, but then there a large gap.
- He ﷺ started to fear that Allah was displeased with him, but than the surah Fajr was revealed. “Your Lord has not foresaken you.”
- Year Two of Prophethood:
 - Rasulullah ﷺ started to spread the word, but secretly.
 - Message: Believe in one God, Rasulullah ﷺ as the final messenger.
 - Began by spreading the message to his family.
 - Called his family for dinner.
 - Famous story of calling family to the mountain. Ali (RA) first to accept – 10 years old!
 - First people to accept Islam were close family/friends (Khadija, Zaid, Ali, and Abu Bakr RA), poor, and youth.

Quraysh Hostilities and Migration to Abyssinia and the Negus




Year 3 of Prophethood:

Revelation would continue to come down. The constant versus revolved around belief in one God, life of the Hereafter and Prophethood. Often, it would come to solve a problem they were having, which showed that God was with them.

Year 4 of Prophethood:

Quraysh started learning of people converting because it had a wide public interest. The Quraysh started getting worried because they started losing business.



Year 4: The revelation came with the command from Allah to openly confront the people, abolish idol worship, and establish monotheism (belief in one God).

Quraysh to stop people listening to message in a lot of different ways.

Quraysh complained to Rasulullah ﷺ 's uncle and want to tell Rasulullah ﷺ to stop his dawah.

They offered him 1. marriage to anyone he wanted, 2. power (to become the leader), 3. any amount of wealth.

Just stop challenging people to accept the deen.

What would we do?

- We would rationalize it 500 ways
- Say ok, if I marry a powerful women /connected and we will convert her and she will convert the rest
- I will take the money and then use that

The First Migration

Year 5 of the Prophethood

The Quraysh started to torture and murder people just because they accepted Islam. A lot of Muslims would hide the fact that they were Muslim.

It came to such a level that the sahaba asked permission to leave the country out of fear for themselves.

Rasulullah ﷺ gave permission for them to leave and migrate to Abyssinia, in Ethiopia because it was known that there was a Christian ruler that was just/fair.

O King! We were ignorant people and we lived like wild animals. The strong among us lived by preying upon the weak. We obeyed no law and we acknowledged no authority save that of brute force. We worshipped idols made of stone or wood, and we knew nothing of human dignity. And then God, in His Mercy, sent to us His Messenger who was himself one of us. We knew about his truthfulness and his integrity. His character was exemplary, and he was the most well-born of the Arabs. He invited us toward the worship of One God, and he forbade us to worship idols. He exhorted us to tell the truth, and to protect the weak, the poor, the humble, the widows and the orphans. He ordered us to show respect to women, and never to slander them. We obeyed him and followed his teachings. Most of the people in our country are still polytheists, and they resented our conversion to the new faith which is called Islam. They began to persecute us and it was in order to escape from persecution by them that we sought and found sanctuary in your kingdom.
