The Ring of Rasulullah ﷺ

- The Prophet (saw) used to send letters to different people to invite them to Islam. At that time, letters were not accepted unless they had a seal or stamp/ring bc otherwise they could be tampered with
- Rasulullah ﷺ had a ring made out of silver. He wore it on his right hand. Said Muhammad Rasulullah ﷺ (Messenger of Allah)
- Abo Bakr (RA) had it after Rasulullah ﷺ passed away
 - *Rasulullah ﷺ's ring and possessions had barakah*

The Seal of Rasulallah ﷺ

- What does a seal/stamp represent? In a letter, it represents the end.
- Rasulallah ﷺ had a physical seal/stamp on his back between his shoulder blades.
- Unique to Rasulallah ﷺ . You may find people with similar hair, build, etc.
- This was Allah's stamp, to show that Rasulallah ﷺ is the last and final Prophet.
- It was present from his birth and disappeared after his death.
- It was a small raised patch of skin with some hair around it. Protusion.
- There's some debate whether words on it.



The Islamic Calendar – The Hijri Calendar



- The calendar up until the Hijrah was calculated based upon Isa (as)'s birth.
- After Rasulallah ﷺ was bestowed his prophethood, based on year of prophethood – 1st, 2nd, 3rd, etc.
- When Rasulallah ﷺ migrated to Medina they started the new calendar – the *Hijri* calendar.
- We are currently in year 1437



The Hijri Calendar

Muharram مُحَرَّم	Jumada al-Awwal جُمَادَى الْأَوَّلَى	Ramadhan رَمَضَانَ
Safar صَفَر	Jumada ath-Thani جُمَادَى الثَّانِي	Shawwal شَوَّال
Rabi' al-Awwal رَبِيعِ الْأَوَّلَى	Rajab رَجَب	Dhul Qadah ذُو الْقَعْدَةِ
Rabi' ath-Thani رَبِيعِ الثَّانِي	Shaban شَبَّان	Dhul Hijjah ذُو الْحِجَّةِ
