Pearls of Purity (Sunnah Acts of Wudu)

Mustahab Acts Disliked Acts in Wudu & Etiquettes of Wudu

- ▶ Facing the qiblah
- ▶ Take the name of Allah before washing each limb
- ▶ To avoid splashes of used water
- ▶ Dua after wudu
- ▶ Excessive use of water, being miserly with water
- ▶ Speaking other than dhikr or dua while making wudu

The Miswak

BENEFITS OF MESWAK:

- ✓ **The greatest benefit of using miswaak is gaining the pleasure of Allah.**
- ✓ **The reward of Salaah (Prayers) is multiplied 70 times if Miswaak was used before it.**
- ✓ **Strengthens the gums and prevents tooth decay.**
- ✓ **Creates a fragrance in the mouth.**
- ✓ **Eliminates bad odors and improves the sense of taste.**
- ✓ **Sharpens the memory.**
- ✓ **Is a cure for headaches.**
- ✓ **Creates luster (noor) on the face of the one who continually uses it.**
- ✓ **Causes the teeth to glow.**
- ✓ **Strengthens the eyesight.**
- ✓ **Assists in digestion.**
- ✓ **Clears the voice.**



Modern day toothbrushing as a regular habit became prevalent in Europe after contact with the Muslim world in Africa and Asia where the people's teeth remained healthy into old age. It was advised as a scientifically supported practice toward the end of the 17th century. The modern toothbrush was developed in England in 1780.

In the United States, although toothbrushes were available at the end of the 19th century, the practice did not become widespread until after the [Second World War](#), when U.S. soldiers continued the toothbrushing that had been required during their military service. ^[5][\[better source needed\]](#)
