When these three letters are used to lengthen the sound of a vowel, the letters by themselves do not take any vowel mark on top or below them. In the following example, letter $\stackrel{\cdot}{\smile}$ has a fatha sign on top, but letter Alif (|) has no vowel sign, as it only lengthens the sound of fatha of letter $\stackrel{\cdot}{\smile}$.

The letter () lengthens the sound of the fatha sign above the previous letter. "Ba" now sounds as long "Baa".
